The Pensacola Mill is a pulp and containerboard manufacturing facility that currently employs over 500 workers and continual presence subcontractors.

The mill produces an average of 1,850 tons of 100 percent pine pulp per day; the largest portion is used by the linerboard machine, and the remainder is used to produce fluff pulp.

The linerboard paper machine (P5) produces an average of 1,400 tons per day of lightweight linerboard that is shipped to container facilities around the globe. Approximately 70 percent of the linerboard produced is delivered to IP's internal box plants while the other 30 percent is sold to external customers.

Pensacola also manufactures an average of 450 tons per day of fluff pulp used to make products such as diapers, feminine hygiene, and adult incontinence products.

Mostly self-sufficient, the mill generates 70 percent of its own energy needs, using natural gas, bark, coal and oil as fuel.

The Pensacola Mill is a large contributor to the region's economy, spending nearly \$300 million in 2007 on payroll, materials, supplies, services and taxes, and is committed to providing a safe work environment for its employees and setting standards in excellence for environmental performance.
